## POLICY:

The Stittsville Minor Hockey Association (SMHA) will offer financial assistance (total or partial) to help ensure that all children living in Stittsville, regardless of their socioeconomic status, have the opportunity to play hockey.

#### ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES:

We will be offering financial assistance to qualified families or player applicant.

#### **Eligibility Criteria**

All applicants are required to first apply for the Hockey Canada Assist Program and submit evidence of their application and resulting decision along with their application to SMHA.

Eligible applicants must:

a) Be approved as a recipient of the Hockey Canada Assist Program;

OR

- b) If not approved meet one of the following criteria and provide evidence:
  - The family is receiving social assistance
  - The family net income is equal to or less than \$60,000 per year
  - The applicant is receiving social assistance



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- The applicant is in a foster care program
- Evidence of assistance that does not meet the above criteria

All approved applicants will be notified by August 31 (before the player's first on-ice session).

### **Application Process**

- Initiate your application by registering your child for the upcoming season. Your registration fees are based on the date of registration. Do not pay your registration fee.
- Email the SMHA VP Finance (VPFinance@stittsvilleminorhockey.com) advising of your intent to apply for the financial assistance program and submit any evidence as required.
- Apply to the Hockey Canada Assist Fund and forward evidence of your application to the SMHA VP Finance.
- All applications will be assessed by the Financial Assistance Committee (FAC) and successful applicants will be notified by August 31.
- Should your application be denied by the FAC, you will be responsible to make payment for your registration fees by September 1.
